Deering Community Church

- We will hold our first Sunday all Ministry/Committee meeting via the internet on the Zoom platform. (If your group needs to meet separately from this, I suggest you use Free Conference Call as it does not limit your time, the number of participants, etc. as does Free Zoom.)
- The good news about these platforms is that even those without computer or internet access can call in and participate by cell or regular phone.

WORSHIP

Will take place on every Sunday we are unable to meet in the church. Those who cannot be in worship at 10:00am can later watch a recording of worship if I figure that out. When attendees enter the Worship, they will be asked to consent to be recorded. If you opt out you will leave Worship. This does not prevent you from watching it later
